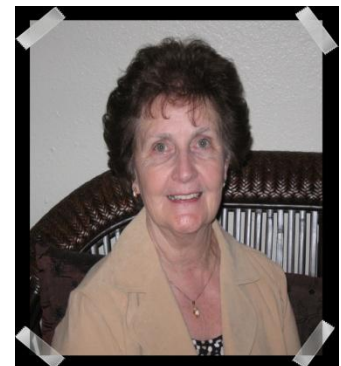
Sandy Price - Delta Epsilon - Wichita
