

## Changes in Constitution & By-laws

Last year at State Council meeting, a constitution and by-laws was adopted, and one mailed to each Chapter in the state. Please clip these amendments, that were made at this year's State meeting, and paste them on your copy.

### Article V. Officers. (add paragraph)

The immediately retiring President shall be the Counselor for the ensuing year.

### Article VI. Duties of Officers.

Under President, omit the last sentence, and add "And such other duties as are implied by her title".

### Add duty of Counselor.

"The Counselor shall advise with the Officers, the Executive Committee, The Board of Directors and the Chapters, as is desired. She shall have charge of the Installation of the new officers.

### Article X. Nominations.

Cancel the present paragraph, and substitute the following:

"There shall be a Committee on Nominations at each annual Council Meeting, which shall consist of one member from each Kansas Chapter in good standing, represented at the meeting. Such members shall be elected by their respective delegations, and their names presented to the State President at the first session of each annual State Council Meeting.

The Committee on Nominations shall meet at the Call of the State President on the first day of the annual meeting, elect a chairman and secretary, and prepare a list of one and not more than two nominees for each office.

Nominations may also be made from the floor.

### Article XVI. Zone Chairmen

The State shall be divided into eight zones—according to the availability of Chapters to each other, considering also the membership in those zones.

Chapters in these zones shall meet annually at the close of the first session of each State Council meeting, to select the Zone Chairman who shall serve that zone for the following year.

It shall be the duty of each Zone Chairman to take active responsibility as a leader in that zone, and to cooperate with the State Council officers.

## State Project

Your Sixth Annual State Council voted to continue the Institute of Logopedics as our project for next year. You will send all contributions to your state Treasurer, so a record may be made. The report May 1 showed for this year \$465.00 had been contributed and additional remittances were being received. In our June issue a statement of this will be made.
