



Stocking Cap pattern

Use size 8 circular needle- 16 inches long
use (Coats & Clark) 4 ply yarn (regular yarn)
Can get 2 – 3 out of one skein of yarn.

Cast on 80 sts.

Knit ribbing of *k 2, p2* for 2 inches.

Switch to stockinet st (k every row) until piece measures 6 inches.

(If using as straight needles, using a seam when finished, k 1 row,
p1 row, until it
measures 6 inches from the beginning.)

Start reduction rows.

- 1) Knit 6 sts, knit 2 together. Repeat around.
- 2) All even rounds – K in stockinet st.
- 3) Knit 5 sts, knit 2 together. Repeat around
- 5) Knit 4 sts, knit 2 together. Repeat around
- 7) Knit 3 sts, knit 2 together. Repeat around
- 9) Knit 2 sts, knit 2 together. Repeat around
- 11) Knit 1 sts, knit 2 together. Repeat around
- 13) Knit 2 together around

Cut tail and thread through loops remaining on needles.

Pull snug. Feed inside, tie off, and cut. Weave in the cut off end.

When you get to row 9, if you switch to double pointed (sock)
needles,

it will be easier to do. They don't have to be the same size, one size
bigger
or smaller is okay.

If using (Bernat) Jiffy yarn, switch to #9 needles – 16 inches long,
and cast on 72 sts.

One ball will make one cap.
